Counting this and opportunities for overtime and shift differential will **boost pay well beyond \$70,000 for many employees.**

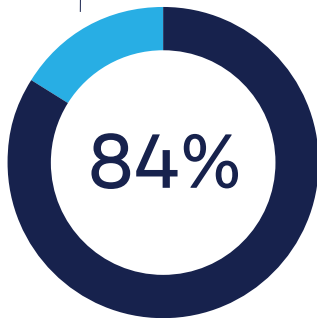


## Attractive Benefits

Less than \$2,000/year in premiums



We cover **84%** of our employees' health care costs so that production employees on average pay less than **\$2,000** per year in premiums.

- Volkswagen contributes **up to 9%** of employees' pay each year towards their retirement between defined contribution and 401k plans.
- Volkswagen invests in Chattanooga families with leading benefits including:
  - Paid parental leave
  - Enhanced infertility benefits
  - Maternity programs
  - Support connecting employees with child care
- We provide a vehicle leasing benefit that more than 40% of our employees take advantage of.

## \$4.3B+ = 125k+ jobs

Since 2009, we have invested **more than \$4.3 billion** in our Chattanooga assembly plant, which has led to **more than 125,000 direct and indirect jobs** as of 2019.



- The unemployment rate in Chattanooga when we broke ground in 2008 was more than 10%. As of Oct. 2023, it is only 3.5% - a testament to our commitment to job creation.
- Since 2010, Volkswagen has invested more than \$9.7 million into non-profit organizations that operate in Chattanooga and Hamilton County.
- In 2023 alone, we gave more than \$500,000 to non-profit organizations in and around Chattanooga.
